
## Ysgol Gyfun Gymraeg Plasmawr - A Level results 2020

Congratulations to all our Year 13 students for their well-deserved success in their A Level, BTEC and Welsh Baccalaureate exams and qualifications. It has been an extremely difficult period for our students since the announcement was made to close schools due to the pandemic and to cancel the final A level exams. The results achieved are a tribute to our student's ability, endeavour, dedication and perseverance over the past two years.

The majority of our students who applied for Higher Education courses have been accepted to the Universities of their choice, a high percentage of which are Russell Group Universities.

I am indebted to my staff for preparing, encouraging, assessing and mentoring their students so well for their A level, Welsh Baccalaureate and BTEC courses and who take so much pride in the achievements of their students. It has been a huge responsibility for teachers to determine the appropriate grades for individual students, but the task was conducted in a fair and professional manner and I am indebted to them for this important work.

However, the moderation process conducted by the WJEC examination board in determining the final A level grades has resulted in a significant reduction in the % of A\* and A grades awarded to our students compared with the school's 3 year rolling average.
