What is an Apprenticeship?

An apprenticeship is a job that includes gaining recognised qualifications and job specific skills whilst working and earning a wage –

'earning while learning'

There are a number of different levels:

- Foundation Apprenticeship Level 2
- Advanced Apprenticeship Level 3
- Higher Apprenticeship Level 4+ (HNC/HND/Foundation Degree)
- Degree Level Apprenticeship Level 6+/Masters



What Qualifications Do You Need?

- Foundation apprenticeships qualifications not always specified but GCSEs at D/E grades often required
- Advanced apprenticeships GCSEs at A*- C grades (usually to include English language, Maths and sometimes Science)
- *Higher level apprenticeships* A Levels or equivalent qualifications
- *Degree level apprenticeships* (up to Masters level) – A Levels or equivalent qualifications




- Full time employment with Capgemini for the scheme and beyond

- It's a technical degree, but you don't need a technical qualification, an interest in technology and a desire to get technical is required
- Entry criteria: A-Levels CCC or equivalent e.g. BTEC's, but if you don't get the expected grades let's talk about it. There is no age limit but it is an entry level scheme

CYRSIAU NETWORK 75 COURSES - 2019/20

Network75 is a combined work and study route to a degree. Undergraduates apply their academic knowledge to real-life work within a host company.

During term-time, students work in a local business 3 days per week and attend university 2 days per week. During holiday periods students work 5 days per week at their host company. All students also get a holiday allowance and study leave for revision.

Earn while you learn

Network75 students receive a minimum tax-free bursary of £5,000 per academic year, which increases by £500 each academic year. Approximately 80% of current Network75 students receive additional payments from their host companies.



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
